## Old Business:

Joel Ewing, President, appointed all regular attendees of Board meetings as the Programs Committee. Other appointed/volunteer positions include Geri Hoerner as Genealogy SIG Liaison, Joel Ewing as Editor, Julie Storm as Publicity Chair, Woody Ogden as Training Center Administrator, Joel Ewing as Webmaster. These positions are not required to be annually reviewed and will continue in present state.

An annual budget for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 was discussed to be completed for next year. Costs remain consistent, except for equipment. Fund raising was also discussed to assist in equipment cost for next year.
